ORDER GRANTING IN SUBSTANTIAL PART PLAINTIFF’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION NOTICE AND PLAN OF NOTICE

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff’s Unopposed Motion for Approval of Class Action Notice and Plan of Notice. The Court, having reviewed the Motion and the relevant portions of the record, ORDERS that the Motion is GRANTED as follows:

1. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure Rule 23, the Proposed Class Action Notice (“the Notice”) is approved in the form attached as Exhibit A, and the proposed plan of disseminating the Notice is approved as modified herein. The court finds that the Notice and the plan of notice as set forth herein are the best practicable and comply with the requirements of Rule 23(c)(2)(B) and meet the requirements of due process.

2. Within 21 calendar days of the date of this Order, Defendants and the Plan Administrator of the American Airlines, Inc. Pilot Retirement Benefit Program Variable Income Plan (“the Plan”) are hereby authorized and ordered to provide Class Counsel and the class action administrator identified by Class Counsel the following contact information for each

known Class Member, to the extent reasonably available in American Airlines, Inc.'s Plan participant files: (1) a street mailing address; (2) telephone number(s); (3) e-mail address(es), including company email accounts provided by American Airlines; and (4) Plan account number(s). Class Counsel and the class action administrator shall treat this information as confidential, and such information shall be used solely for the purposes of this litigation.

3. Class Counsel, via the class action administrator to be retained by Class Counsel, shall send the Notice, in a form substantially similar to the one attached hereto to by both U.S. Mail and e-mail, to the extent such addresses have been provided, to the members of the Class identified by Defendants within 21 calendar days after receipt of class member data from the Plan Administrator.

4. Class Counsel shall submit a declaration from Class Counsel or the class action administrator confirming compliance with the Notice procedures of this Order within 35 days of receipt of class member data from the Plan Administrator.

5. All requests to be excluded from the Class must be postmarked no later than 60 days after notice, and shall be addressed to: Cohen Milstein Sellers & Toll PLLC, Attn: R. Joseph Barton / Exclusion from American Airlines Class Action, 1100 New York Avenue, N.W., Suite 500, Washington, D.C. 20005-3934. Each request to be excluded shall state the person's name, address, telephone number, and that he or she wants to be excluded from Allman v. American Airlines, Inc. Pilot Retirement Program Variable Income Plan, et al., No. 14-cv-10138-IT (D. Mass.), and must be signed by the person.
