**ORDER GRANTING

Petitioner Patrick Fleetwood filed a judicial review of Washington State University's (WSU) February 21, 2020, University Appeals Board decisions finding Patrick Fleetwood violated WSU's Standards of Conduct, including WAC 504-26-227 (Sexual Harassment), WAC 504-26-209 (Violation of University Policy Rule or Regulation) and WAC 504-26-219 (Abuse of Student Conduct System). The Court heard oral argument of Matt Crotty, attorney for Petitioner, and Nathan Deen, attorney for Respondent, and considered:


Therefore, all sanctions levied by WSU against Patrick Fleetwood pursuant to the February 21, 2020, University Appeals Board decision is likewise set aside.
